#### Primary Narrative:

Fire personnel were dispatched to a possible fire in the basement. Chief 3 arrived to find smoke showing on sides Alpha and Bravo. Residents were standing outside with 2 dogs. Chief 3 took command and made contact to verify all members were out of the house

Squad 2 arrived and went to the alley and pulled a pre-connect for fire attack. Engine 14 grabbed a hydrant on the way in and pulled a back up hose line. Engine 5 did a primary search on the first and second floors with an all clear on both. One cat was found and brought to side alpha where Ambulance 1 assisted with resuscitation of the cat. Ladder 23 controlled utilities and a primary search of the basement with an all clear as well. Ladder 22 was R.I.T. and Chief 1 was the safety officer with 360 completed and no additional hazards.

Squad 2 and Engine 14 reported the fire was knocked when Squad 2 ran short on water. Engine 20 assisted with water to Squad 2 and then redeployed to assist with negative ventilation of the basement. Engine 14 lost power on the engine and needed to exit the structure and Engine 20 replaced them with a second hose line from Engine 20. Fire was reported out and fire investigation duties began.

Squad 2, Ladder 23, Engine 5 assisted with overhaul. Homeowner was displaced from the residence but did not need assistance with a place to stay. Xcel gas and electric arrived and secured the building. Inspector 12 worked with the homeowner on any needs along with board up. Board up was called but homeowner refused there help. All companies cleared the scene.
