





#### **Population Growth in Saint Paul**








### Spending Power & Tax Contributions of Immigrants in Saint Paul





#### Immigrants Are More Likely to Be Entrepreneurs


# 1 in 5 entrepreneurs

They employ **8 million** Americans and generate **\$1.3 trillion** in sales.

#### **Entrepreneurship in Saint Paul**

Foreign-born residents account for **33.2% of entrepreneurs** in Saint Paul, and generated **\$43.8 million** in business income for the city in 2019.














## Spending Power & Tax Contributions of Immigrants in East Metro Area, Minnesota
