This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on September 21, 2021 at which we were unable to reach you, Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond recommended that the City Council grant an extension to November 1, 2021 to have the Fire Certificate of Occupancy reinstated and to waive the Vacant Building fee for 90 days (to November 17, 2021). If the Fire Certificate of Occupancy is not reinstated by that date the property will revert to a Category 2 Vacant Building and must be vacated.
