### VACANT BUILDING REGISTRATION FEE WARNING LETTER

The Saint Paul City Council has adopted legislation which requires owners of vacant buildings to pay an annual fee and submit a registration plan on the form(s) enclosed with this letter. The annual fee is \$2,127.00. The purpose of this fee is to partially reimburse the City for administrative costs for registering and processing the Vacant Building Owner Registration forms and for the cost of monitoring these properties for compliance with Saint Paul Legislative Codes.

The fee for the vacant building located at 912 ROSE AVE E is now past due. You have fifteen (15) days from the date of this letter to pay this bill before this fee is sent to assessment, to be collected with your property taxes.

DO NOT MAIL CASH

Saint Paul Legislative Code, Chapter 43, requires this fee be paid no later than thirty (30) days after the building becomes vacant, and if not paid, the owner shall be subject to collections and prosecution as prescribed in the Legislative Code. Also, if at any time the registration fee is unpaid and owing, building permits will be denied for this building.

The full amount owed will be assessed to, and collected with, the taxes for this property as permitted by Saint Paul Legislative Code Chapter 43.

The owner(s) still will be subject to a criminal Summons and Complaint for failure to pay this vacant building registration fee. This citation will necessitate a court appearance in Ramsey County District Court and the owner(s) will be subject to penalties provided for by law. The enclosed registration form must accompany the fee payment.

If the registration fee is not received in this office within 45 days of the date of this letter, the full amount owed will be assessed to, and collected with, the taxes for this property as permitted by Saint Paul Legislative Code Chapter 43.

The Code Enforcement Officer has notified the Building Inspection and Design Section that this property meets the legal definition of a registered vacant building and in accordance with Legislative Code Chapter 33, no permits (except demolition, wrecking and removal permits) will be issued until the requirements of all applicable ordinances are fulfilled.

All catergory 2 and category 3 vacant buildings must be winterized with gas and water services shut off or, alternately, an excess flow gas valve must be installed in the dwelling, within sixty (60) days of the date of this notice.

The Enforcement Officer may declare this building to constitute a Nuisance Building subject to demolition and issue an Order to Abate under authority of Legislative Code Chapter 45. In the event this building is declared a Nuisance Building, subject to demolition, the Enforcement Office will notify all owners and interested parties of the Order to Abate as provided in the Legislative Code Chapter 45.

## Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

912 ROSE AVE E

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was determined to be a registered vacant building on September 9, 2021. Since certificates are for the occupancy of buildings, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy.

Saint Paul Legislative Code provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. In order to re-occupy the building, the following deficiencies (if applicable) must be corrected and a complete Certificate of Occupancy inspection will be required.

### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- Exterior Back of Property MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. 1. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-The conduits coming from the electrical meter has disconnected at the bottom. Properly reconnect the conduit.
- Exterior Concrete Foundation SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.33 (3) Provide and maintain 2. foundation elements to adequately support this building at all points. -There is a section of the concrete foundation that is cracked, damaged and has holes.
- Exterior House SPLC 34.09 (1)(2), 34.33 (1) Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. -There is a section of rotted/damaged board at the back side of the house.

There is peeling paint on the window frames.

- 4. Exterior Parking Surface SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-8989.-The Class 5 gravel is no longer maintained and has vegetation growing through it. Remove the vegetation and refresh the Class 5 gravel.
- 5. Exterior Shed SPLC 34.08(5), 34.32(3) All accessory structures including, but not limited to, detached garages, sheds and fences shall be maintained structurally sound and in good repair. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements. -The back wall of the shed is damaged and popped out.
- 6. Interior Basement Door MSFC 1008.1.9.3 Remove unapproved locks from the exit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort. -There is a small latch and unapproved lock on the basement door.
- 7. Interior Bathroom SPLC 34.14 (2) c Repair or replace the duplex convenience outlet with ground fault protection within 3 feet of the basin on an adjacent wall in all bathrooms. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-The GFCI outlet in the bathroom does not work.
- 8. Interior Bathroom SPLC 34.14 (3), MPC 4714.01 (T) Provide and maintain a window or approved ventilation system in all bathrooms. -The bathroom window has a screw on the top preventing the window to open and provide ventilation.
- 9. Interior Dryer Duct MMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.

  The dryer exhaust ducts is disconnected at the bottom and on the other side of the wall the duct has been improperly connected, supported and taped.
- 10. Interior Kitchen MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical fixtures. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-The GFCI outlet in the kitchen makes a buzzing sound when being tested. Replace this outlet.
- 11. Interior Smoke Alarms MSFC 1103.8.1Replacement of smoke alarms. Single- and multiple-station smoke alarms shall be replaced when:1. They fail to respond to operability tests.2. They exceed ten years from the date of manufacture. Smoke alarms shall be replaced with smoke alarms having the same type of power supply. -The hardwired smoke alarms are expired and the one in the upstairs bedroom has failed to test.

- 12. Interior Smoke Alarms MSFC 907.2.10.5Interconnection. Where more than one smoke alarm is required to be installed within an individual dwelling unit or sleeping unit in Group R or I-1 occupancies, the smoke alarms shall be interconnected in such a manner that the activation of one alarm will activate all of the alarms in the individual unit. Physical interconnection of smoke alarms shall not be required where listed wireless alarms are installed and all alarms sound upon activation of one alarm. The alarm shall be clearly audible in all bedrooms over background noise levels with all intervening doors closed.
- 13. Interior Throughout SPLC 34.12 (2), SPLC 34.36 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition to properly and safely perform their intended function in accordance with the provisions of the applicable code. There are light fixtures missing covers.

  The mirror in the bathroom is broken.
- 14. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
