Final Order approving the construction of a new sidewalk on York Avenue between Earl Street and Frank Street. (File No. S1304, Assmt. No. 135304)

The new sidewalk is approximately 150' long on the north side of the street, and approximately 280' long on the south side of the street. The new sidewalk will complete the first stretch in the Phalen Corridor pathway.
