WHEREAS, LISC will pay for all costs associated with attendance and participation in the meeting by Mr. Bayers, with an estimated value not to exceed \$1,500; and
WHEREAS, this three-day event will discuss how to attract businesses to St. Paul's commercial corridors and the analysis of commercial real estate developments; and
