Requesting that the City levy property taxes for the library agency. (This item was vetoed by the Mayor on September 22, 2016.)

WHEREAS, in accordance with Saint Paul Administrative Code §14.05, Mayor Coleman presented to the Library Board on August 10, 2016, the Library Agency's 2017 proposed budget, with said recommended budget totaling \$18,788,012; and

WHEREAS, the budget requested by the Library Agency and proposed by the Mayor includes, as part of the comprehensive 2017 financing plan for the Saint Paul Public Library Agency, that the net property tax levy payable in 2017 be \$17,621,116 as detailed below:

WHEREAS, the Library Board amends the Mayor's recommended tax levy as follows:
