Authorizing application to the Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development for a redevelopment grant for the Custom House site.

BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Saint Paul, Minnesota act as the legal sponsor for the project contained in the Redevelopment Grant Program application to be submitted on February 3, 2014 for the Custom House site and the 2700 University site and that the Director of the Saint Paul Department of Planning and Economic Development is hereby authorized to apply to the Department of Employment and Economic Development for funding for this project on behalf of the City of Saint Paul, Minnesota.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Saint Paul, Minnesota has the legal authority to apply for financial assistance, and the institutional, managerial, and financial capability to ensure adequate project administration.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sources and amounts of the local match identified in the application are committed to the project identified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City certifies that it has not violated any Federal, State or local laws pertaining to fraud, bribery, graft, kickbacks, collusion, conflict of interest, or other unlawful or corrupt practice; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon approval of its application by the State, the City of Saint Paul, Minnesota may enter into an agreement with the State of Minnesota for the above referenced project, and that the City of Saint Paul, Minnesota certifies that it will comply with all applicable laws and regulation as stated in all contract agreements; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute such agreements as are necessary to implement the project on behalf of the applicant.
