WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 20-1460 accepted the Report of Completion for Collection of Vacant Building Registration Fees billed during the time period of February 14 to July 20, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has considered objections of affected property owners and developed recommendations for the City Council with respect to their assessments; and
