**RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing and Redevelopment Authority of the City of Saint Paul, Minnesota that:

1. The HRA Board of Commissioners hereby approves and authorizes submission of a grant application to the Economic Development Administration (EDA) Agency of the U.S. Department of Commerce for the American Rescue Plan Act Economic Adjustment Assistance Notice of Funding Opportunity (ARPA-EAA NOFO) requesting \$1,250,000.

2. The HRA Board of Commissioners hereby approves and authorizes the reservation of \$250,000 of HRA Business Assistance Funds as the committed match if the ARPA-EAA NOFO grant is awarded to the HRA.

3. The HRA Executive Director, staff, and legal counsel for the HRA are hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to implement this Resolution, and the HRA's Executive Director is specifically authorized to execute any documents and instruments necessary to carry out this Resolution.
