WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has reviewed the assessment roll, considered appeals of affected property owners and developed recommendations for City Council with respect to those assessments; and

WHEREAS, the following assessments were appealed:

RLH TA 11-246 - 920 Forest Street - Approve the assessment;
RLH TA 11-234 - 702 Preble Street - Forthcoming;
RLH TA 11-230 - 929 Wilson Avenue - Delete the assessment;

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on August 17, 2011 to consider ratification of assessment roll; and
