Moriarty said that seat was for her obese son to use. In addition, Moriarty's daughter did not open the mail while Moriarty was away, so the SAO was not seen in time. When it turned into an assessment, Moriarty received the assessment hearing information in time, she returned the gold card, but she assumed she would get something forthcoming in the mail, which is not the case. Moriarty is not disputing that the work was done, and the items are not a result of dumping.
