**Stated Reason for Appeal (if given):** The back bill added to the assessment is incorrect.

**Staff Comments:** Original assessment was for \$601.78 and consisted of the base cost of \$120.94 and a back bill of \$480.84. Staff confirmed with hauler the back bill of \$480.84 on the original assessment was incorrect. Therefore, staff recommends removing the entire remaining assessment of \$480.84.
