Approving adverse action against the Taxicab Vehicle license for Cab #5366 held by Nadif Ketibe, d/b/a Twin Cities Cab.

WHEREAS, the Taxicab Vehicle license for Cab #5366 held by Nadif Ketibe d/b/a Twin Cities Cab (License ID #20130000881) for the City of Saint Paul, was the subject of a Notice of Intent to Revoke License dated January 28, 2014, stating that DSI records indicate the service company he was affiliated with no longer meets the minimum of five (5) active licensed taxicabs in its fleet; and

WHEREAS, Saint Paul Legislative Code § 376.10 (b) (2) requires that "a service company must maintain a minimum of five (5) licensed vehicles. If the number of licensed vehicles drops below five (5), the remaining licenses shall be revoked"; and

WHEREAS, the licensee did not respond to the Notice of Intent to Revoke License to request a public or administrative hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Intent to Revoke License stated that if the licensee failed to request a public or administrative hearing by February 7, 2014, that the matter would be placed on the consent agenda to impose the recommended penalty; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Taxicab Vehicle license for Cab # Cab #5366 held by Nadif Ketibe d/b/a Twin Cities Cab is hereby revoked.
