Amending the financing and spending plans in the Fire Department in the amount of \$341,727.27 to accept the 2022 Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) to provide turnout gear and paramedic training for firefighters. WHEREAS, the Fire Department has received a grant of \$375,900 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Assistance to Firefighters Grant program which has a federal share of \$341,727.27 and a 10% matching fund contribution of \$34,172.73 to provide turnout gear and paramedic training for firefighters; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the grant application on Resolution 23-171; and

WHEREAS, federal law requires a 10% matching fund contribution of \$34,172.73 will be paid from the Fire Department's budget; and

WHEREAS, the financing and spending plans have not been established for the grant received; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation funds of \$341,727.27 in excess of those estimated in the 2023 budget; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council approves the changes to the 2023 budget as specified in the attached financial analysis.
