Ratifying the assessments for Boarding and/or Securing services during November 2018. (File No. J1906B, Assessment No. 198105)

WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 19-75 accepted the Report of Completion for Emergency Boarding and/or Securing of a Structure on Private Properties during the month of November 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has reviewed the assessment roll, considered appeals of affected property owners and developed recommendations for City Council with respect to those assessments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on April 17, 2019 to consider ratification of the assessment roll; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered and found satisfactory the assessment of benefits, costs and expenses for the services provided; now, therefore be it
