WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 23-1661 accepted the Report of Completion for Excessive Use of Inspection or Abatement Service for the Property Code Violations billed during the time period of June 22 to July 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has considered objections of affected property owners and developed recommendations for the City Council with respect to their assessments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on February 28, 2024 to consider ratification of the assessment roll; and
