Approving adverse action against the House Sewer Contractor license held by Doboszinski & Sons, Inc. d/b/a Doboszinski & Sons, Inc. for the City of Saint Paul.

WHEREAS, adverse action was taken against the House Sewer Contractor license held by Doboszinski & Sons, Inc. d/b/a Doboszinski & Sons, Inc. (License ID #200800000876) for the City of Saint Paul, by Notice of Intent to Suspend License dated March 29, 2012, alleging licensee failed to pay delinquent license and late fees of \$250.00, submit a current \$10,000 Surety Bond and list of employee's names who have taken the test with Saint Paul Public Works Sewer Division; and

WHEREAS, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.05 (m) (2), the licensing office also recommended a \$500.00 matrix penalty for failure to submit required information in order to maintain the license; and

WHEREAS, the licensee did not respond to the Notice of Intent to Suspend License to pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit required information; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Intent to Suspend License stated that if the licensee failed to pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit required information by April 9, 2012, that the matter would be placed on the consent agenda to impose the recommended penalty; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the House Sewer Contractor license held by Doboszinski & Sons, Inc. d/b/a Doboszinski & Sons, Inc. is hereby suspended for failure to pay delinquent license and late fees of \$250.00; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, the licensee is ordered to pay a matrix penalty of \$500.00 for failure to submit required information in order to maintain the license. Payment of such penalty shall be made within thirty (30) days of the date of the adoption of this resolution.
