



- 1) The Variances shall be for the hours of 4:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. with a pre-event sound check at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 11, 2023 for the MNUFC v New York Red Bulls game and for Saturday, March 25, 2023 for the MNUFC v Vancouver Whitecaps game.
- 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA as measured at 50 feet from all sound sources.
- 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment who shall provide continuous sound level monitoring at each sound source during the hours of the variance.
- 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 7:30 p.m. on March 11, 2023, and March 25, 2023, the event dates.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that any violations of the conditions set forth above on the March 11, 2023 and March 25, 2023 dates may result in denial of future requests for the grant of a noise variance, in addition to any criminal citation which might issue.

Minnesota United FC, represented by Zacharia Litzelswope, has requested an exemption from the sound level limitations in Chapter 293.07 in order to present amplified sound for the MNUFC v New York Red Bulls game on Saturday, March 11, 2023, as well as for the Saturday, March 25, 2023 MN UFC v Vancouver Whitecaps game, with limitations, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. with a pre-event sound checks at 3:00 p.m. Chapter 293.09 provides for the granting of variances from the sound level limitations contained in Chapter 293.07.
