WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation funds of \$13,750 in excess of those estimated in the 2014 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends the addition as specified in the Attachment "MBFTE Financial Analysis \$13,750" be made to the 2014 budget:
