WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 21-450 accepted the Report of Completion for Collection of Vacant Building Registration Fees billed during the time period of October 5 to December 22, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has considered objections of affected property owners and developed recommendations for the City Council with respect to their assessments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on June 16, 2021 to consider ratification of the assessment roll; and
