WHEREAS, the financing and spending plans have not been established for this grant, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation funds of \$15,000 in excess of those estimated in the 2020 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends the following addition be made to the 2020 budget:
