



- 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 90 dBA at 50 feet from all sound sources
- 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment who shall provide continuous sound level monitoring at each sound source during the hours of the variance.
- 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 15, 2024, the event date.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that any violations of the conditions set forth above on the Saturday, June 15, 2024 date may result in denial of future requests for the grant of a noise variance, in addition to any criminal citation which might issue.

Kyle Rucker, has requested an exemption from the sound level limitations in Chapter 293.07 in order to present amplified sound, with limitations, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. with a pre-event sound check at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday June 15, 2024. Chapter 293.09 provides for the granting of variances from the sound level limitations contained in Chapter 293.07.
