WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation has received additional funding in the amount of \$25,825 to be used toward the Youthprise Program; and

WHEREAS, Parks and Recreation has developed a spending plan to best utilize this additional funding and therefore wishes to increase both financing and spending budgets by \$25,825; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, pursuant to Section 10.07.01 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation, funds of \$25,825 in excess of those estimated in the current Grant Budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Saint Paul authorizes acceptance of the grant funds and approves these amendments for the Life-to-date Grant Budget.
