Staff Comments: The Q1 2020 delinquent bill was sent to the City of Saint Paul on April 5, 2020 as an assessment. Since the payment was made on April 8, 2020 it would not have been applied to the Q1 2020 bill. Therefore staff recommends approving the assessment.
