Approving adverse action against the Restaurant (L) - Limited license held by Sabrina M. Yang, d/b/a Tea Vana located at 217 Como Avenue, Unit #107 in Saint Paul.

WHEREAS, adverse action was taken against the Restaurant (L) - Limited license held by Sabrina M. Yang d/b/a Tea Vana (License ID #20090002219) for the premises located at 217 Como Avenue, Unit #107 in Saint Paul by Notice of Intent to Suspend License dated February 9, 2011, alleging licensee failed to pay delinquent license and late fees of \$407.00 and submit a completed Certificate of Compliance Minnesota Workers Compensation Law form; and

WHEREAS, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.05 (m) (2), the licensing office also recommended a \$500.00 matrix penalty for failure to submit required information in order to maintain the license; and

WHEREAS, the licensee did not respond to the Notice of Intent to Suspend License to pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit the required information; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Intent to Suspend License stated that if the licensee failed to pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit the required information by February 22, 2011, that the matter would be placed on the consent agenda to impose the recommended penalty; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Restaurant (L) - Limited license held by Sabrina M. Yang d/b/a Tea Vana is hereby suspended for failure to pay delinquent license and late fees of \$407.00; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, the licensee is ordered to pay a matrix penalty of \$500.00 for failure to submit required information in order to maintain the license. Payment of such penalty shall be made within thirty (30) days of the date of the adoption of this resolution.
