Stated Reason for Appeal (if given): PO states that they already paid this bill and that they never received an overdue bill notice from WM
Staff Comments: PO states that they paid this on time, but were assessed anyway. Waste Management has no proof that a Notice of Non-payment was sent. WM found that the assessment was for a different parcel. PO provided proof of payment from 7/25/2023. City solid waste staff recommends full removal of assessment totaling \$119.89
