WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation funds of \$39,130 in excess of those estimated in the 2022 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends the additions as specified in the attachment "MBFTE Financial Analysis \$39,130" be made to the 2022 budget; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Saint Paul City Council accepts the contribution of \$39,130 and thanks the Minnesota Board of Firefighter Training and Education for their generous contribution, and approves the changes to the 2022 budget.
