Approving adverse action against the Mobile Food Vehicle license held by Cingie King, d/b/a V F King Food, for the City of Saint Paul.

WHEREAS, adverse action was taken against the Mobile Food Vehicle license held by Cingie King d/b/a V F King Food (License ID #20090002963) for the City of Saint Paul by Notice of Intent to Suspend License dated October 7, 2010, alleging licensee failed to pay delinquent license and late fees of \$316.00; and

WHEREAS, per Saint Paul Legislative Code § 310.05(m) (2), the licensing office also recommended a \$500.00 matrix penalty for failure to submit information required to maintain the license; and

WHEREAS, licensee did not respond to the Notice of Intent to Suspend License to pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit required information or request a hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Notice of Intent to Suspend License stated that if the licensee failed to pay the delinquent license and late fees and submit required information or request a hearing by October 18, 2010, that the matter would be placed on the consent agenda to impose the recommended penalty; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Mobile Food Vehicle license held by Cingie King d/b/a V F King Food is hereby suspended for failure to pay delinquent license and late fees of \$316.00.

FURTHER RESOLVED, Cingie King d/b/a V F King Food is hereby ordered to pay a matrix penalty of \$500.00 for failure to submit required information in order to maintain the license. Payment of such penalty shall be made within thirty days of the date of the adoption of this resolution.
