WHEREAS, in accordance with Saint Paul Administrative Code §14.05, Mayor Carter presented to the Library Board on August 19, 2021, the Library Agency's 2022 proposed budget, with said recommended budget totaling \$20,413,029; and

WHEREAS, the budget requested by the Library Agency and proposed by the Mayor includes, as part of the comprehensive 2022 financing plan for the Saint Paul Public Library Agency, that the net property tax levy payable in 2022 be \$18,774,155 as detailed below:
