



- 2) All electronically powered equipment used in conjunction with the event shall not exceed 80 dBA, as measured at 50 feet from the noise source.
- 3) The applicant shall provide personnel and equipment who shall provide continuous sound level monitoring at all stages and each sound mix during the hours of the variance.
- 4) All electronically powered equipment, PA systems, loudspeakers or similar devices shall be turned off no later than 6:00 p.m. on October 21, 2018.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that any violations of the conditions set forth above on the October 21, 2018 event date may result in denial of future requests for the grant of a noise variance, in addition to any criminal citation which might issue.

Public Kitchen & Bar LLC., represented by James Crockarell, has requested an exemption from the sound level limitations in Chapter 293.07 in order to present outdoor music and announcements, with limitations, from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 21, 2018 with a pre-event sound check at 10:30 a.m. at 400 Sibley St. during their Hog Smoke Fest. Chapter 293.09 provides for the granting of variances from the sound level limitations contained in Chapter 293.07.
