WHEREAS, the licensee currently holds a Wine On Sale and Malt On Sale (Strong) license; and

WHEREAS, the premises is located downtown so a petition is not required; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Safety and Inspections received no objections to the issuance of the licenses; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the application is in order and there are no grounds for denial of the Liquor Outdoor Service Area (Patio) and Entertainment A licenses; now, therefore, be it,

RESOLVED, a Liquor Outdoor Service Area (Patio) and Entertainment A licenses are hereby granted to Big River Pizza, Inc. d/b/a Big River Pizza, Inc. (License ID #20150000849) for the premises located at 280 - 5th

Street East in Saint Paul with the following recommended additional conditions:						
4.	Per City of Saint Paul Legislative Code 411.02, the definition of Entertainment A is, "Amplified or nonamplified music and/or singing by performers without limitation as to number, and group singing participated in by patrons of the establishment." (includes karaoke). Entertainment A license does not allow for patron and/or performance dances."					

- 5. Licensee agrees to take appropriate measures to ensure that the entertainment provided does not adversely affect the neighboring tenants (residential or commercial).
- 6. No outdoor entertainment is allowed without prior written approval from DSI.
