WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File RES 17-1804 accepted the Report of Completion for Demolition of Vacant, Nuisance and/or Hazardous Structure from the month of August 2017 at 1027 Case Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has reviewed the assessment roll, considered appeals of affected property owners and developed recommendations for City Council with respect to those assessments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on February 7, 2018 to consider ratification of the assessment roll; and
