WHEREAS, the Saint Paul Foundation is also providing \$936 to support the protection and maintenance of the environment and ecology in the City of Saint Paul and its suburbs; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, pursuant to Section 10.07.01 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation funds of \$8,930 in excess of those estimated in the current Grant Budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Saint Paul authorizes acceptance of the grant funds and approves these amendments for the Life-to-date Grant Budget.
