Staff Comments: The garbage hauler mailed out the original invoice on 1/5/19. The due date was 1/25/19. The hauler also sent out a notice of non-payment on 1/31/19 and a final notice of non-payment on 3/31/19. Because payment was not received by the end of Quarter 1 2019, the property owner is now responsible for paying the total delinquent balance to the City.
