WHEREAS, the Mayor, pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation funds of \$500,000.00 in excess of those estimated in the 2011 budget, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends the following addition be made to the 2011 budget:
