

legitimate public and governmental purpose by addressing economic disparities, and promoting health and welfare of the Saint Paul community at large; and

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota requires agencies accepting Whole Family Systems grants enter into a five-year collaborative learning relationship from January 1, 2020 through June 30, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, the total amount of the grant is \$2,000,000 to be awarded over five years, with a yearly grant award of \$400,000 each year for SFY19-SFY24; and

WHEREAS, the City authorized the Office of Financial Empowerment to apply for and accept this grant as outlined in RES 19-634; and

WHEREAS, the financing and spending plans have not been established for the grant; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor pursuant to Section 10.07.1 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriations funds of \$400,000 in excess of those estimated in the 2019 budget; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council that \$400,000 is available for appropriation in the 2019 budget, and said budget, as heretofore adopted by Council, is hereby amended as outlined in the attached financial analysis.
