WHEREAS, Parks and Recreation has developed spending plans to best utilize these new funding sources to support the Right Track Youth Employment Program; and

WHEREAS, Parks and Recreation wishes to establish new budgets for each of these funding sources in the City's Grant Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, pursuant to Section 10.07.01 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul, does certify that there are available for appropriation, funds of \$72,767 in excess of those estimated in the current Grant Budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Saint Paul authorizes acceptance of the grant funds and approves these amendments for the Life-to-date Grant Budget.
