History of Orders on Property: SA issued on 4/1/15 for multiple trash bags and scattered refuse in backyard; work was done by owner. Correction notice issued on 5/15/15 for garage found in disrepair, missing windows, doors falling apart, peeling and chipping paint all around; compliance date 6/15/15. TG&W letter sent on 5/21/15; inspector noted grass was over eight inches; work order sent to Parks. On 5/26/15, Parks found lawn was mowed by owner; inspector issued PAEC.
