WHEREAS, the Office of Financial Services Real Estate Section has attached to this Council File both a report of completion outlining the costs and fees associated with Collection of Vacant Building Registration fees billed during February 28 to August 22, 2018. (File No. VB1904, Assessment No. 198803 File No. VB1904A, Assessment No. 198810) and the assessment roll including all properties for which these assessments are proposed for Council ratification; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has reviewed an appeal of this assessment and

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developed a recommendation for the City Council with respect to this assessment; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing having been conducted for the above improvement, and said assessment having been further considered by the Council and having been considered financially satisfactory; Now, Therefore, Be It

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Chapter 14 of the Saint Paul City Charter, said assessment is hereby laid over to Public Hearing on March 20, 2019 and if permits are finaled and certificate of code compliance is issued, will reduce the vacant building fee reduced from \$2284 to \$1142, ratified and made payable in one installment.
