Making finding on the appealed nuisance abatement ordered for 1332 DAYTON AVENUE in Council File RLH RR 18-28.

AMENDED 3/6/19

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted RLH RR 18-28 on August 20, 2018 which granted an extension for 180 days to abate the nuisance conditions at 1332 Dayton Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Hearing Officer reviewed this case on February 26, 2019 to determine if the owner and/or responsible party abated the nuisance conditions and found these conditions were not abated but owner has met 85% completion and will continue the current performance deposit and grant an additional 180 days if <u>as</u> an updated work plan and financing <u>are has been</u> submitted <u>and approved by the Department of Safety and Inspections Code Enforcement Manager and the Legislative Hearing Officer; now, therefore, be it</u>

RESOLVED, that the Saint Paul City Council adopts the finding of the legislative hearing officer that the nuisance condition is not abated
