**Stated Reason for Appeal (if given):** The hauler, WM, contacted the City, stating, the city needs to pull the 3rd Qtr 2023 assessment amount of \$119.89 ... off the tax rolls for Parcel #202922430075. This is a duplex and WM had two separate accounts for this property. At one time it was considered single family and then went to a duplex. Previous owner didn't realize until now that he still had one account that was never canceled back in May 2023
