Staff Comments: This property is listed as a three-family dwelling in Ramsey County property tax records. According to information provided by Republic Services, the property owner was charged for 3 total carts: 2 35-gallon Small Every Other Week carts and 1 96-gallon Large cart. Republic Services did not provide the property owner with any credits on the Quarter 4 2018 bill. The property owner is responsible for the bill, as garbage service was provided for 2 35-gallon Small Every Other Week carts and 1 96-gallon Large cart from October through December 2018.

WHEREAS, the Office of Financial Services Real Estate Section has attached to this Council File both a report of completion outlining the costs and fees associated with Collection of Delinquent Garbage Bills for services during October to December 2018.
