Stated Reason for Appeal (if given): I will not pay a bill that I do not owe. This is a copy of my current bill showing the past balance was paid. No late fee was assessed. Neither my 3 calls to the city nor my calls to Waste Management have resolved this. Waste Management says that I don't owe them money and won't take care of this problem.

Staff Comments: All delinquent garbage bills are sent to the City of St. Paul for assessment after three months. Therefore, delinquent bill for the property was sent to the City of St. Paul around 10/05/2019. This has been reflected in the pending assessment amount of \$15.04. Staff recommends approving assessment.
