Appeal of Robert H. Nollet to a Certificate of Occupancy Revocation Vacant Building and Vacant Building Registration Renewal Notice at 676 RIVOLI STREET.

For stealing income by vacating my building, then billing me for \$1,100 plus my other costs (mortgage, taxes, insurance, heat, and utilities) and destroying my family's retirement for housing code violations that I have corrected but were not hazardous to life and were tenant-caused but never re-inspected by Inspector James Thomas.
