Authorizing the appropriate City officials to enter into Memorandums of Understanding with participating VISTA Sites.

WHEREAS, the City of Saint Paul will enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS) for the period of the 2017-2018 VISTA program year, pursuant to which it will act as a Sponsor organization; and
