Public hearing to consider the appeal of Dick Huss to a decision of Heritage Preservation Commission denying the replacement of three casement windows on the north and south elevations at 300 Maple Street (745-747 Third Street East) in the Dayton's Bluff Historic district.

Purpose: Appeal of a Heritage Preservation Commission decision denying the replacement of three casement windows on the north and south elevations. (The HPC approved the reconstruction of the parapet and corbelled cornice, the re-pointing of the facade and the replacement two windows and one door on the east elevation and that part of the decision is not being appealed.)

Staff Recommendation: partial approval  
Heritage Preservation Commission Decision: partial approval, 4 to 3 (Ferguson, Riehle, Igo) with one abstention (Trimble),  
Support: 0 people spoke, 0 letters were received  
Opposition: 0 people spoke, 0 letters were received
