**Stated Reason for Appeal (if given):** I submitted a service hold request to Berquist garbage haulers, and Waste Mgmt. took over in April 2019 for Berquist routes and must have billed me when i should not have been billed until June 30th due to the service hold request being submitted to Berquist to start Jan. 1, 2019.

**Staff Comments:** Waste Management confirmed that the property owner had a temporary service hold in place from 1/1/19 to 6/30/19. Staff recommends deleting this assessment. Staff sent a letter on 9/25/19 informing the property owner that the assessment would be removed.
