**Staff Comments:** Notices of nonpayment were sent to the mailing address that was request. In addition, payment for the Quarter 3 bill was not submitted until 10/2019, was not able to be processed until after delinquent account was sent to the City of Saint Paul Assessments Office as a pending assessment. Therefore, as the payment of \$25.16 was applied as a credit to the resident's account, staff recommends approving the assessment.
