WHEREAS, the Saint Paul City Council in Council File 11-18700 accepted the Report of Completion for Weekly Trash Hauling on Private Properties during the time period of August 03 to August 31, 2011; and WHEREAS, the City Council's Legislative Hearing Officer has reviewed the assessment roll, considered appeals of affected property owners and developed recommendations for City Council with respect to those assessments; and

WHEREAS, the following assessments were appealed:

RLH TA 11-401 - 612 Cook Avenue East;

RLH TA 11-403 - 717 Fry Street a/k/a 1642 Minnehaha Avenue West; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on January 04, 2012 to consider ratification of assessment roll; and
